

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ADOPT THE CONFLICT OF INTEREST CODE OF THE PUBLIC CABLE TELEVISION AUTHORITY

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of Directors of the Public Cable Television Authority (the "Authority") intends to adopt the Authority's Conflict of Interest Code (the "Code") pursuant to Government Code Section 81000.

The Code designates those employees, members, officers, and consultants who make or participate in the making of decisions and are subject to the disclosure requirements of the Authority's Code. The Authority's proposed Code shows that the Authority needs to formally adopt the Standard Conflict of Interest Code provided by the Fair Political Practices Commission (FPPC) which incorporates 2 Cal. Code of Regs. Section 18730 by reference as the provisions of the Code, declares officials that manage the investment of public funds, lists all positions required to be designated in the Code, including Consultants and New Positions, and establishes a list of disclosure categories for assignment to designated positions and consultants based on the duties of each position.

The proposed Code will be considered by the Board of Directors on October 16, 2024, at 9:00 a.m. at the Authority Office, 7800 Katella Ave., Stanton, California, 90680.

Any interested person may be present and comment at the public meeting or may submit written comments concerning the proposed adoption.
